THE TOURNAMENT:

Each participant must have a current membership in, and actually compete in; a USBC certified Indiana Local Association. Non-Indiana residents shall be required to have a validated average of 21 games or more in an Indiana USBC certified league. Youth members are not allowed to participate in this tournament.

SATURDAY FORMAT: Lanes will be Oiled before Each squad

The Indiana Masters Tournament will be conducted on a SPORT BOWLING Pattern throughout the weekend.

9:30 AM Squad Bonus: The Top 4 Bowlers from 9:30 AM will be guaranteed at least 48th place. With the Top 2 being seeded at least 16th.

Four (4) Squads of qualifying will be conducted on Saturday to determine the competitors for the Semi-Finals

Each entrant will bowl (3) three games across (6) six lanes. This is a SCRATCH Tournament so actual pinfall will determine the players that will advance to the Semi-Finals on Sunday.

Entries taken on a first paid basis until squad is full. Bowlers not checked - in 20 minutes before squad time may be replaced with bowlers on the waiting list. REFUNDS ON PAID ENTRIES will be charged a \$10. Fee.

SUNDAY FORMAT: Players **seeded** based on their qualifying scores from Saturday.

If 300 or MORE ENTRIES the TOP 48 Players (and ties) ADVANCE

Places 1 thru 16 (and ties) will be seeded into TOP 32 MATCH PLAY FINALS.

Places 17 thru 48 will bowl 2 games and use the combined 5 GAME TOTAL (Qualifying and Semi - Finals) to determine the balance and seeding into the TOP 32 MATCH PLAY FINALS.

If LESS THAN 300 ENTRIES the TOP 32 ADVANCE to the TOP 32 MATCH PLAY FINALS.

TOP 32 will bowl, a single game match, double elimination, to determine the champion.

OTHER PERTINENT INFO:

A DRESS CODE will be enforced during the INDIANA MASTERS Tournament. Each participant will be required to wear DRESS SLACKS (no denim jeans, sweats or shorts) and a SHIRT with a COLLAR. Mock Turtle neck shirts will only be allowed if they have a bowling logo and meet PBA Guidelines. No hats or headgear allowed. Ladies must wear Dress Slacks or a Skirt. No Shorts, Capris or Leggings Those individuals not complying with the dress code will not be permitted to bowl

The decision of the Tournament Manager is Final. Management may refuse any Entry

Sweepers on Friday will be conducted on the same "Pattern" used during the Indiana Masters Tournament

Brackets and HIGH Game Pots will be administered by the INDIANA USBC BA

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. **ELIGIBILITY:** Each participant <u>must</u> have a current USBC membership in, <u>and actually compete in;</u> an USBC certified Indiana Local Association. **Non-Indiana residents shall be required to have a validated average of 21 games or more in an Indiana USBC certified league. Affiliate memberships are not allowed. Each participant is Eligible to compete as many times in the Indiana Masters tournament as openings are available. Youth Members are not eligible to participate in this tournament.**
- 2. The MASTERS Tournament will be conducted on a "SPORT BOWLING" lane condition.
- 3. Walk-in entries on Saturday will be permitted until 20 minutes prior to the start of the final squad. If the squad is not full. Entries cannot be transferred to another bowler. Management may refuse an entry.
- 4. No more than five (5) bowlers per pair of lanes during qualifying. Maximum 6 bowlers per pair during sweeper.
- 5. **A DRESS CODE** will be enforced during the **TOURNAMENT**. Each participant will be required to wear **DRESS SLACKS** (no denim jeans, sweats or shorts) and a **SHIRT** with a **COLLAR**. No t-shirts allowed. Mock Turtle neck shirts will be allowed only if they have a bowling logo and meet PBA guidelines. **No headgear or hats**. Ladies must wear Slacks or a Skirt. No Shorts, Capris or Leggings Those individuals not complying with the Dress Code will not be permitted to bowl.
- 6. Each participant will bowl three (3) games across six (6) lanes. Each participant will be permitted ten (10) minutes of practice on each of their starting lanes ONLY. No more than 3 re-racks will be permitted per participant unless authorized by a designated tournament official.
- 7. Sunday Semi Finals and Finals will be determined by Entries during qualifying.

If there are 300 or more entries then the TOP 48 and ties will advance to Sunday. Places 1 thru 16 (and ties) will be seeded into the Top 32 Match Play Finals. Places 17 thru 48 will bowl 2 games and use the combined 5 game total (Qualifying and Semi Finals) to determine the balance and seeding into the TOP 32 Match Play. If after 5 games a tie exists for 32nd place there will be a 1 game roll-off. If still tied 9th and 10th frame used.

If there are less than 300 entries the TOP 32 will go directly to Match Play.

Match Play will use the single game, double elimination format to determine the Champion.

- 8. Bowlers arriving late for the Semi-Finals or Finals on Sunday will be given a **ZERO** for each frame missed.
- 9. All participants are required to be at the host center 45 minutes prior to the start of their scheduled squad.

 Management reserves the right to fill any vacancy 20 minutes prior to the start of a squad with walk-in bowlers or refuse any entry. All participants are subject to USBC rule 322a (a zero count for frames missed).
- 10. In the event of a breakdown or delay, the Tournament Manager will make a decision regarding the continuation of the game/games.
- 11. All decisions of the Tournament Manager are final, pending any appeal to USBC.
- 12. No Individuals are permitted in the bowling area except the participants and tournament officials.
- 13. Regular entries close at midnight January 12th, 2018. Full payment of entry must be received prior to the deadline to receive discount of \$15.00. **REFUNDS of a paid entry will be charged a \$10. Fee**
- 14. **PRIZE FEES:** Prize fees will be returned 100%, paid at least 1 in 5 ratio.
- 15. Money order or cashiers check must accompany all early entries, **NO PERSONAL CHECKS**Make cashier checks and money orders payable to: **THE INDIANA MASTERS Cash Only** will be accepted for walk-in entries on the day of qualifying competition.
- 16. After PRACTICE for the current squad, NO surface adjustments or cleaners may be used. Dry Towels only.
