Article VI, Section C – Officers' Term	1 Year
Article VII, Section A – Annual Meeting Delegates Structure	Each local association shall be entitled to 3 delegates.
Article VII, Section A – Annual Meeting Credentials	Credentials are forwarded to the state association <u>at least 90 days prior</u> to the opening of the annual meeting.
Article VII, Section A – Annual Meeting Quorum	60 Delegates
Article VII, Section B – Board Meeting Quorum	10 Board Members
Article VII, Section B – Board Meeting Action(s) Without a Meeting	The association <u>Does</u> allow the Board to vote via mail, email or teleconference.
Article X, Section A – Amendment Submission Procedure	Submitted at least <u>90</u> days prior to the meeting when the association is considering the proposal.
Article X, Section A – Amendment Review Procedure	Forwarded by the state association at least <u>30</u> days before the meeting.
